



Rules and Regulations

- Games are played between two teams of seven players, and each game consists of a maximum seven overs.
- Each member of the fielding side bowls one over with one bowler bowling 2 overs, wicket-keeper cannot bowl.
- Wide and no-balls count as three runs, balls counted
- The last over of the innings is a normal over with no-ball and wide ball not being counted and only one run is given to the batting side.
- Free Hits do not apply after a no-ball.
- The last remaining batsman bats on with the fifth batsman acting as a runner. He always takes the strike. The innings is complete when the seventh wicket falls.
- Batsmen retired not out on reaching a personal score of 30+ runs. Although he can come back to bat once all the wickets fall.
